

Easy Scarf Pattern



If you've been inspired by our cosy Warm Trees, why not try knitting your own scarf?

If you're new to knitting, or need a refresher, there are plenty of helpful online videos and websites to guide you. Start with the basics, such as how to cast on, then move on to simple stitches like the garter stitch.

This simple pattern will help you create a snug scarf to keep you warm this winter. Feel free to get creative, choose bright colours or take inspiration from the unique bark and leaf tones of our trees!

What you need:

- 8 ply yarn
- 400m - 450m yarn
- 4.00mm (US 6) or 4.50mm (US 7) knitting needles

Pattern:

- Cast on 30 stitches.
- Row 1: Knit.
- Repeat row 1 until the scarf is approximately 1.5 m long or your desired length.
- Bind off and weave in ends.
- Finished scarf is approximately 15cm wide and 1.5 m long.
