

Pattern for Eucalyptus Leaf

Abbreviations:

St = Stitch

R# = Row number

(#) = number of stitches in row

k = knit

p = Purl

incl = Increase a stitch by knitting into the front and back of the stitch.

dec1 = decrease a stitch by knitting two stitches together.

Pattern

Using 8 ply green yarn and size 4mm knitting needles

- Make 1 stitch (1)
- R1 k st (1)
- R2 inc by knitting into the front and back of the stitch (2)
- R3 Inc 1, k1, p1 (3)
- R4 k2, incl (4)
- R5 k3, p1, (4)
- R6 incl, k2, incl (6)
- R7 k4, p1, k1 (6)
- R8 incl, k5, (7)
- R9 k4, p1, k2 (7)
- R10 incl, k6 (8)

R12 inc1, K7	(9)
R13 k4, p1, k4	(9)
R14 k9	(9)
R15 – R30 Repeat R13 & R14 x 8	
R31 k4, p1, k4	(9)
R32 k7, dec1	(8)
R33 k3, p1, k4	(8)
R34 k8	(8)
R35 - R40 Repeat R33 & R34 x 3	
R41 k3, p1, k4	(8)
R42 dec1, k4, dec1	(6)
R43 k2, p1, k3	(6)
R44 k6	
R45 – R48 Repeat R43 & R44 x 2	
R49 k2, p1, k3	(6)
R50 dec1, k1, dec1	(4)
R51 k1, p1, k2	(4)
R52 k4 (4)	
R53 k1, p1, k2	(4)
R54 dec1, k2	(3)
R55 k1, p1, k1	(3)
R56 dec1, k1	(2)
R57 k1, p1	(1)
R58 dec1	(1)

Tie off last stitch and weave in ends of wool.
